First Year, 75 mile, Judge, Professional, and Lifetime memberships have the same benefits as the Full membership category.

AFSC will reimburse the Regionals' entry fee for AFSC home club skaters (full membership category) in good standing competing in qualifying events and will help to defray some costs for skaters competing in Sectionals and National Competitions. The Sectionals and Nationals reimbursement amount is left to the discretion of the AFSC Board of Directors. For collegiate, this reimbursement is limited to \$20.

An AFSC club officer must sign your Regional application form indicating that you are a member in good standing. To be considered a member in good standing you must have paid at least the first installment towards your AFSC membership dues. Before your Regionals' entry fee is reimbursed to you, your AFSC membership dues must be paid in full and you must have no other financial obligation to AFSC outstanding.
